The City of McMinnville Launching New Business Programs on May 10, 2023

McMinnville, OR – The City of McMinnville is announcing the launch of several new resources for businesses located in the McMinnville city limits. The programs are designed to address the lingering workforce and business issues related to the ongoing impacts of COVID-19. The programs were established by the City of McMinnville’s Economic Vitality Council as the McMinnville Recovery and Resiliency Plan and are funded by a State American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA fund secured by former Representative Ron Noble (HD-24 in the 2021 Oregon Legislative Session).

PROGRAMS LAUNCHING MAY 10, 2023

Free Bilingual Business Training & Mentorship Program: Are you a business owner/manager exhausted and facing burnout from the ongoing issues related to COVID-19? This program will get you energized to tackle any situation! Applications open May 10 to June 7, 2023. BBC Consulting has been engaged to develop and deliver this program.

The McMinnville Small Business 40/60 Forgivable Loan for up to \$20,000 with 40% of the loan forgiven if all requirements are met. Application opens May 2023. Application assistance is available. Micro Enterprise Services of Oregon (MESO) will be administering the loan program.

The McMinnville Business Assistance Grants are for up to \$15,000 for employee recruitment and retention. Applications open May 10 and close July 12, 2023. Grant awards do not need to be repaid if all requirements are met. The City of McMinnville will manage the grant program with marketing and application assistance provided by Advanced Economic Services.

In addition, the McMinnville Economic Development Partnership (MEDP) has been contracted to deliver sustainable workforce coordination providing data driven workforce solutions and long-term programming for the McMinnville business community.

Programa gratuito de capacitación y asesoría empresarial bilingüe: ¿Es usted dueño o gerente de una empresa, está cansado y con agotamiento debido a los problemas actuales relacionados con el COVID-19? Este programa le dará energía para afrontar cualquier situación. Las inscripciones están abiertas del 10 de mayo al 7 de junio de 2023.

Para pequeñas empresas de McMinnville, el préstamo es condonable al 40/60, de hasta \$20,000, con condonación del 40 % del préstamo si se cumplen todos los requisitos. La inscripción comienza en mayo de 2023. Se ofrece ayuda para inscribirse.

Se ofrecen subvenciones de ayuda a las empresas de McMinnville

de hasta \$15,000, para la contratación y retención de empleados. Las solicitudes comienzan el 10 de mayo y terminan el 12 de julio de 2023. No es necesario devolver las subvenciones concedidas si se cumplen todos los requisitos.

El Plan de Recuperación y Resiliencia Empresarial de McMinnville es un fondo de la Ley del Plan de Rescate Estadounidense (ARPA) que obtuvo el exdiputado Ron Noble (HD-24) en la Sesión Legislativa de Oregón de 2021 para ayudar a tratar las repercusiones actuales de la pandemia del COVID-19.
